- 3 Whether the plaintiff proves that the sale deed dated 16.06.2003, 11.08.2004, 19.01.2004 and 01.02.1999 are not binding on the share of the plaintiff?
- 4 Whether the defendant No.8 proves that he is a bonafide purchaser of item No.5 of suit schedule properties?
- 5 Whether the suit is barred by law of limitation?
- 6 Whether the suit is bad for non-inclusion of all the family properties?
- 7 Whether the plaintiff is entitled for declaration as sought for?
- 8 Whether the plaintiff is entitled for partition and separate possession of suit schedule properties?
- 9 Whether the plaintiff is entitled for "A" share in the suit schedule properties?
