Today is fixed for hearing on sentence and passing sentence accordingly.

The convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) is physically produced from J/C today.

Ld. P.P. in-charge is present.

Ld. Defence Counsel is present.

Heard the convict person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) on the point of sentence.

Heard the Ld. P.P. in charge on the point of sentence.

Heard the Ld. Advocate of the accused on the point of sentence.

Sentence is ready and pronounced in open Court in presence of the accused person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) and in presence of the Ld. Advocate of the accused and in presence of the Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Sentence is prepared in separate pages containing five (05) pages which is signed and sealed by the Presiding Officer and is kept with the record. The operative part of the Sentence is as follows:

“Hence, it is

Ordered

That the convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) is sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for the term of one month for the offence committed by him u/s 341 of the Indian Penal Code.

That the convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) is sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for the term of one year for the offence committed by him u/s 323 of the Indian Penal Code.

That the convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) is sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for the term of ten years and is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.10,000/-, in default, rigorous imprisonment for three months is awarded to the convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) for the offence committed by him U/s.326 of the Indian Penal Code.

That the convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) is sentenced to imprisonment for life and fine of Rs.15,000/-, in default, rigorous imprisonment for six months is awarded to the convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) for the offence committed by him U/s.307 of the Indian Penal Code.

That the convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) is sentenced to punishment of imprisonment for life and fine of Rs.15,000/-, in default, rigorous imprisonment for six months is awarded to the convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) for the offence committed by him U/s.302 of the Indian Penal Code.

The period of detention already undergone by the convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) in this case be set off against the term of imprisonment imposed on him in accordance to the provisions of Section 428 Cr.P.C.

All the sentences awarded to the convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) shall run concurrently.

Seized alamats, if any, be destroyed after the expiry of period for preferring appeal against the judgment and order or after the appeal if preferred is disposed of.

Let a copy of this judgment be given to the convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) free of cost as per provision of section 363(1) Cr.P.C.

It has been informed to the convicted person namely, Sanjoy Singh @ Rana Singh (A-1) that he has right to prefer an appeal against the judgment and order of sentence and for this purpose, and if he desires so, he can take the assistance of State Legal Services Authority for the preference of the appeal.

Let a copy of the judgment be forwarded to the District Magistrate, Paschim Bardhaman as per provision of Section 365 Cr.P.C.
