- 1 Whether the plaintiffs prove that suit schedule properties are the joint family properties?
- 2 Whether the plaintiffs further prove that the defendants have denied to make partition of the suit schedule properties in spite of their request?
- 3 Whether the defendants prove that the suit of the plaintiffs is not maintainable because of earlier partition made about long back?
- 4 Whether the defendants further prove that item No.2 of suit schedule property is the absolute property granted by the Government in favour of the father of the 6th defendant i.e., Varadanaika?
- 5 Whether the defendants further prove that the plaintiffs cannot claim their share in respect of item No.2 of property as per the judgment and decree passed against the defendants in O.S.281/2023?
- 6 Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to get reliefs as sought in the plaint?
- 7 What order or decree?
