

ORDER ON I.A. DATED 25.01.2023

The defendant has filed the application under Order VI Rule 17 r/w Section 151 C.P.C. to delete paragraph No.3 and to add certain paragraphs as detailed in the application, when the case was posted for plaintiff's evidence.

2. Plaintiff has not filed statement of objections.

3. Heard.

4. The suit is for the relief of specific performance. In the written statement the original paragraph No.3 is in respect of entering of agreement to sell between the plaintiff and the defendant for certain consideration. By deleting the said paragraph the defendant wishes to add some more paragraphs which in detail explain the process of the sale agreement entered into between the plaintiff and the defendant. The plaintiff has not filed statement of objections. The proposed amendment will not take back the admission if any made by the defendant. The proposed amendment only clarifies the defence of the defendant and it will not cause any hardship to the plaintiff. Therefore, for proper adjudication of the suit it is necessary to permit the defendant to amend the

written statement as sought for by her. Hence, the following:

ORDER
