

AD-INTERIM INJUNCTION ORDER

The suit is filed for the relief of partition and separate possession of their 2/4th share in the suit schedule property. Along with the suit I.A.I is filed for temporary injunction.

The learned counsel for the plaintiffs argued to grant ad-interim temporary injunction against the defendants restraining them from alienating schedule property till disposal of the suit. The learned counsel further argued that, in case the defendants alienate the schedule property, the plaintiffs would suffer irreparable injuries.

Ad-interim temporary injunction can be granted in extreme circumstances if plaintiffs able to prove the very necessity to grant such order. Suppose if the property is alienated before adjudication of the matter, it would definitely cause injustice to the plaintiffs because their valuable right over the property if any will be spoiled if alienation is made. Therefore, the subject matter of

the suit schedule property is to be kept intact. Therefore, the following:

ORDER

Issue ad-interim temporary injunction against the defendants preventing them not to alienate the suit schedule property till the next date of order, if the plaintiffs complied the Order XXXIX rule 3(a) of CPC.

Issue suit summons and notice of IA No.I to the defendants, if PF is paid.
