

ORDERS ON IA NO.VII

This is a suit for Partition and Separate Possession over the suit schedule property. Counsel for plaintiffs have filed IA-7 U/O.XXXII Rule 3 of C.P.C., seeking appoint the defendant No.1(a) as guardian of the defendant No.1(b), since he is minor.

In the affidavit filed in support of IA-7, the 1st plaintiff has stated that, the defendants No.1(b) is minor. Therefore, he is not in a position look after the proceedings in this suit personally in a proper manner. Therefore, the defendant No.1(a) is mother and she is fit person as guardian of the defendant No.1(b). Hence, plaintiffs sought for allow the application.

In the present case defendants No.1 (b) is minor and defendant No.1(a) is mother of minor defendant No.1(b). Hence, suit being one for partition as right of all parties to the suit is involved and Defendant No.1(b) being minor, in order to protect his interest his mother is just and proper to be appointed as natural guardian. Accordingly this court proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

I.A.No.7 filed u/O 32 R 3 of CPC is hereby allowed.

The defendant No.1(a) is hereby appointed as natural guardian of defendant No.1(b).
