- 4 Whether the Defendants No. 4 to 8 further proves that one Mutthegowda sold property of Sy.387/1 measuring 3 acre 13 gutas to Eregowda on 08.06.1932?
- 5 Whether the Defendants No. 4 to 8 further proves that the plaintiffs have not brought suit in the name of all necessary parties?
- 6 Whether the Defendants No. 4 to 8 also proves that suit of the plaintiff is time barred and suit is not properly valued?

7 Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to get the relief as sought in the plaint?
