It reveals that instant petition is filed by petitioner under Order 1 Rule 10(2) CPC r/w Section 151 CPC with a prayer to add Arunava Das as a party on the ground that he is the nominee for disbursement, settlement of appropriate sanctioned amount at LIC, Tarakeswar, Branch on the demise of Binoy Ranjan Sur on 16.01.2023. In the instant case the Court is of the opinion that Arunava Das is the necessary party as the issue in dispute. As such, the petitioner wants to incorporate the name of this person as defendant. Therefore, the Court finds no reason to not allow the instant petition.

that the petition u/Order 1 Rule 10(2) CPC r/w 151 CPC is hereby considered and allowed.

Let Arunava Das be added as party in the cause title of the suit.
