- 3 Whether the plaintiff further proves that the registered gift deed executed by the 1st defendant in favour of the 2nd defendant dated 30.03.2023 is null and void?
- 4 Whether the defendants No.1 and 2 prove that the suit schedule property was the ancestral property of themselves?
- 5 Whether the defendants No.1 and 2 further prove that the suit schedule property is their absolute property as it is allotted through registered partition deed?
- 6 Whether the plaintiff is entitled to get the relief as sought in the plaint?
- 7 What order or decree?
