The suit is filed for seeking the relief of declaration and permanent injunction. The temporary injunction claimed is not to alienate the suit B schedule property till the next date of hearing. Considering the pleadings and material placed on record a prima facie case is made out at this stage. If the ex parte order of temporary injunction is not granted, the very purpose of the suit may get defeated by reason of delay, in case the property is sold and the purchaser puts forth the plea of bonafide purchaser for consideration. Hence, the following

ORDER

The defendant No.1 or persons acting on his behalf are hereby restrained from alienating the suit B schedule property, till the next date of hearing, by way of ad-interim ex parte order of temporary injunction on I.A. No.1.

The plaintiff shall comply order 39 rule 3 of CPC.

Issue ex parte T.I order and

notice on I.A. No.1 and suit
summons to the defendants, if
the above order complied,
returnable by 27/8/2019.
