- 4 Whether the suit is barred by law of limitation?
- 5 Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for partition and separate possession of suit schedule properties?
- 6 Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for 1/5th share in the suit schedule properties?
- 7 Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for declaration as sought for?
- 8 Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for permanent injunction as sought for?
