- 5 Whether the defendants 5 and 6 prove that they are the bonafide purchasers of item No.6 suit schedule property?
- 6 Whether the suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties?
- 7 Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for partition of suit schedule properties?
- 8 Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for 4/5th share in the suit schedule properties?
- 9 Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for declaration as sought for?
- 10 Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for mesne profits as sought for?
