- 4 Whether the plaintiff further proves that he is in peaceful possession of the suit schedule property?
- 5 Whether the plaintiff further proves the interference of the defendants?
- 6 Whether the defendants No.1 and 2 prove that there is no cause of action for the suit?
- 7 Whether the defendants No.1 and 2 further prove that they are in peaceful possession of the suit schedule property and improved it?

- 8 Whether the plaintiff is entitled to get the relief as sought in the plaint?
