4. Whether the Legal Representatives of the defendant No. 1 further proves that, there is an earlier partition effected between plaintiff and deceased defendant No.1, as per Palu Patti Dated 11.5.1992 ?
5. Whether the Legal Representatives of the defendant No.1 further prove that, the suit of the plaintiff for fresh partition and separate possession is not maintainable ?
6. Whether the Legal Representatives of the defendant further proves that, suit is not properly valued and the court fee paid on plaint is insufficient?
