

Accused No.6 and 7 are Present.

Learned defence counsel has filed Memo along with receipt having paid the fine amount.

Section 23A(1) of MMDR Act empowers of a person authorized under section 22 of the act to compound any offence punishable under MMDR Act or any rule made thereunder, either before or after the institution of the prosecution on payment of such sum as specified by the authorized person, for credit to the government.

The accused No.6 and 7 have produced a copy of Challan bearing No.MG1225004311718960 dated 10.12.2025 to prima facie show that the accused No.6 and 7 have paid a sum of Rs.4,000/- with the complainant for credit to the government as required under section 23A of the MMDR Act.

Hence on being satisfied as to compliance of section 23A(1) of MMDR Act, this court proceeds to pass the following ;

ORDER

Compounding of the alleged offences in the case by the complainant under section 23A(1) of MMDR Act is accepted.

Consequently, further proceeding in the case against the accused No.6 and 7 in respect of the offences so compounded is dropped as per section 23A(2) of MMDR Act and consequently case is closed against accused No.6 and 7.
