

**ORDER ON I.A.IV FILED UNDER ORDER III RULE 2(a)
OF CPC**

This is an application filed by the applicant, who is the general power of attorney (GPA) holder of the plaintiff, seeking permission to appear, conduct and adduce evidence on behalf of the plaintiff.

2. In support of the application, the applicant has filed an affidavit stating that the plaintiff is his elder brother. Due to his ill health and medical condition, he is unable to attend the court proceedings. The plaintiff has executed a valid General Power of Attorney dated 18.02.2026, authorizing the applicant to act on his behalf. The applicant contends that allowing him to conduct the case and lead evidence will not cause any injustice or inconvenience to the defendant, whereas denial would result in hardship to the plaintiff.

3. On the other hand, the defendants have not filed their objections.

4. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record. The suit is filed by the plaintiff seeking relief of permanent injunction. The GPA holder is the brother of the plaintiff and is well acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case, including the transactions relating to the suit schedule property. The applicant has clearly stated his inability to attend court due to his health issues.

5. Considering the relationship between the plaintiff and the GPA holder, and the nature of the suit, this Court is of the

opinion that permitting the GPA holder to conduct the case and adduce evidence on behalf of the plaintiff will not cause any prejudice to the defendant. Hence, this Court proceeds to pass the following:

ORDER

The application filed under Order III Rule 2 (a) of CPC is hereby **allowed.**

The plaintiff is permitted to sue the case and adduce evidence through his GPA holder, **Sri Narayanaswamy S/o Siddanayaka** on his behalf.
