

The Plaintiff has filed this suit against the defendants for the relief of declaration and permanent injunction of the suit schedule property and other incidental reliefs.

Perused the plaint averments, I.A.No.I and the connected affidavit and documents.

On perusal of the materials on record, it appears that the plaintiff has made out a prima facie case, to go in for the trial. If an ad interim ex-parte order of T.I. is not granted on I.A.No.I, the purpose of filing the suit would not serve to the plaintiff. Hence, notice on I.A.No.I is dispensed and this court proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

The plaintiff shall comply with the provision contemplated under Order 39 Rule 3 of C.P.C.

Office is directed not to issue certified copy of this order till the compliance is made.
