ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN P.W.D.V.A. No. 13/2022
[Aarati Swapnil Swami v. Swapnil Dayanand Swami and ors.]

This is an application under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act-2005.

02. The applicant and her learned advocate Shri. S.C.Valsange have appeared before the Court. The applicant has filed withdrawal pursis (Exh.11) contending that, she does not want to proceed with present application. She prayed that, the matter may be disposed of as per withdrawal pursis (Exh.11).

03. Heard the applicant and the learned advocate, at length. Contents of withdrawal pursis (Exh.11) were read over and explained to the applicant. She has voluntarily admitted correctness of contents of withdrawal pursis (Exh.11). She submitted at bar that, the dispute between her and non-applicants has been amicably settled as per terms and conditions mentioned in withdrawal pursis (Exh.11). She has not remained any grievance against non-applicants. Hence, she does not want to proceed further against non-applicants. The applicant has lastly prayed that, the case may be disposed of as per withdrawal pursis (Exh.11).

04. Learned advocate for the applicant submitted at bar that, the case is amicably settled between the applicant and non-applicants as per terms and conditions mentioned in withdrawal pursis (Exh.11). Therefore, he prayed that, the case may be disposed of as per withdrawal pursis (Exh.11).

05. Considering above facts and circumstances and submissions of the applicant and her learned advocate, it appears that, the case is

amicably settled between the applicant and non-applicants as per terms and conditions mentioned in withdrawal pursis (Exh.11). It also appears that, the applicant has not remained any grievance against non-applicants. It further shows that, the applicant does not want to proceed further against non-applicants. Considering above facts and circumstances and submissions of the applicant and her learned advocate, withdrawal pursis (Exh.11) came to be read and recorded as per detailed order passed thereon. Therefore, in view of above peculiar facts and circumstances, it is just and proper to dispose of present matter as per withdrawal pursis (Exh.11). Resultantly, I pass following order :-

ORDER

In view of withdrawal pursis (Exh.11), the matter is hereby disposed of as withdrawn.
