State vs Soukat Ali

Accused Soukat Ali has appeared before this Court. Seen the complaint, Memo of arrest, Seizure list, Personal Search List, Arrest Report, Confessional Statement, PR bond and Prosecution report. Seen the PR submitted against the above-named accused person.

No Advocate is representing the accused person. Thus. R. P. Roy, Ld. Advocate from the panel of DLSA, Jalpaiguri is appointed as Legal Aid Advocate to represent the accused person. Ld. Adv/DLSA on behalf of the accused person has submitted a petition praying for pleading guilty. Perused the record. Heard accused person in person on the point of pleading guilty. Considered. On being asked, the accused person also expresses his willingness to plead guilty voluntarily in open Court. So, he is permitted to plead guilty as his plea appears to be voluntarily made. Accordingly the substances of acquisition as revealed from the prosecution report, for commission of offence punishable U/S 144 of Railways Act is read over and explained to the accused person and on being asked whether he is guilty or not the accused person voluntarily pleaded guilty by saying "Doshi". The plea being voluntarily made is accepted and acted upon. Therefore, the accused person(s) namely **Soukat Ali** is hereby convicted (u/s 252 Cr.P.C) for commission of offence punishable U/S 144 of Railways Act.

The accused person submitted that he belongs to very poor family and sole earning member of his family. So, he prays for lenient punishment. Considered.

Hence it is

ORDERED

On being found the accused person namely **Soukat Ali** is **guilty and therefore he has been convicted and accordingly the accused person is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 500/- i/d to suffer simple imprisonment for seven (07) days for the offence punishable u/s 144 of the Railways Act.**

The seized properties, if any, shall be confiscated in favour of state, after expiry of the appeal period as per law. Let a copy of this order be given to the convict at free of cost and one copy be sent to the concern E.O for his information and necessary action & for report compliance immediately.

The case is disposed of in an uncontested form. Note in concerned register. BC -II to com1ply.
