

ORDER ON THE APPLICATION

FILED U/S 480 OF BNSS

The learned counsel for the accused Nos.1 to 3 filed bail application to enlarge the accused on bail for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3) r/w Section 3(5) of B.N.S. The accused further submitted that they are permanent residents of Nanjangud Town and they have got old aged parents and they are ready to furnish solvent sureties to the satisfaction of this court. Hence, they prayed to grant bail.

2. Per contra the prosecution filed objections saying that the offences alleged against the accused are grievous in nature and they are punishable with 7 years imprisonment of either nature. Suppose accused are enlarged on bail, they will not appear before the court in future and they will tamper the prosecution witnesses. Hence, prays to reject the application.

3. Heard both sides.

4. As mentioned supra the Town Police Station has registered the case against the accused for the alleged offences, but the said offences are exclusively triable by this court. Already the accused are once

released on bail by J.M.F.C. Court at Nanjangud in Cr.No.30/2025. Thereafter due to change of circumstances and gravity of offences another Section has been added, thereafter the matter was transferred to this court. As mentioned above, the offences are exclusively triable by this court and charge-sheet already been filed. It shows that further presence of the accused in judicial custody is definitely not required and unwarranted. The apprehension of the prosecution may be met by imposing suitable conditions. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The application filed by the accused Nos.1 to 3 under Section 480 of B.N.S.S. is allowed by imposing the conditions below:

1. Accused Nos.1 to 3 shall execute personal bond for Rs.50,000/- each with one surety for the likesum.
2. Accused Nos.1 to 3 shall not involve in similar offence in future.
3. The accused Nos.1 to 3 shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses and shall appear before the court regularly.
