

Perused the plaint, I.A.No.I filed u/Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 of CPC., seeking an ad-interim exparte order of temporary injunction from putting up construction by defendants or anybody on their behalf in suit schedule item No.C property whatsoever pending disposal of the suit schedule property.

Heard and perused the materials placed before this court.

On perusal, this court comes to a conclusion that, if before notice of IA No.1 is served on defendants, there is a possibility of construction by defendants in suit schedule property. If that situation arises, no purpose will be served, even temporary injunction is granted. Accordingly, grounds are made out for passing an exparte order of temporary injunction, therefore the following order :-

ORDER

As per IA No.I, temporary injunction is granted in favour of the plaintiff against the defendants till next date of hearing.

The defendants or anybody acting on their behalf are hereby restrained by way of temporary injunction from putting up

construction over the suit schedule item No.C property, till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply Order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.
