

Perused the plaint, I.A.No.I filed u/Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 of CPC., seeking an ad-interim exparte order of temporary injunction by restraining the defendants, their agents, servants or anybody acting on their behalf from interfering with the plaintiff's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule property till the disposal of the suit.

Heard and perused the materials placed before this court.

On perusal, this court comes to a conclusion that, if before notice of IA No.1 is served on defendant, there is a possibility of interfering with the plaintiff's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule property. If that situation arises, no purpose will be served, even temporary injunction is granted. Accordingly, grounds are made out for passing an exparte order of temporary injunction, therefore the following order :-

ORDER

As per IA No.I, temporary injunction is granted in favour of the plaintiff against the defendants till next date of hearing.

The defendants are hereby restrained from interfering with the plaintiff's peaceful

possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule property till next date of hearing.

The plaintiffs shall comply Order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.
