1. Whether plaintiff proves that the suit properties are ancestral and joint family properties of himself and defendants-1 to 7?
2. Whether defendants-6 & 7 prove that the joint status was severed under oral partition on 10.10.99 between plaintiff, defendants-1 & 6 as contended in para-17 of their written statement?
3. Whether defendants-6 & 7 prove that suit item-3 is the separate property of defendant-7 as contended in para-13 of their written statement?
4. Whether defendants-8 & 10 to 12 prove that the joint status was severed about 35 years back under oral partition as contended in para-13 of their written statement?
5. Whether defendants-8 & 10 to 12 prove that suit item-6 and suit items-8 to 10 were sold in favour of defendant-8 and Puttegowda father of defendants-10 to 12 under sale deeds dated 29.03.93 and 26.10.06 respectively for legal necessity?

- 6.** Whether suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties?
- 7.** Whether suit is bad for non-inclusion of all properties?
- 8.** Whether suit is barred by limitation?
- 9.** Whether suit is properly valued and Court fee paid is sufficient?
- 10.** Whether plaintiff proves that he is entitled for partition and separate possession of 1/5<sup>th</sup> share in the suit properties?
- 11.** What order or decree?
