Sri.CG advocate filed Vakalath for D3 along with IA No.11 u/o 9 rule 7 of CPC to set aside the ex-parte order made against him.

Advocate for plaintiff submits no objection to allow the application. Hence IA No.11 is allowed. D3 is permitted to proceed with the case.

Plaintiff and defendants present and they filed compromise petition U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC.

On read over the contents of the compromise both parties accepts its correctness and submits to allow the compromise.

An application u/o 32 rule 7 of CPC by the father of D4 seeking permission to entered into compromise on behalf of minor D4. The compromise is in the best interest of minor D4. Therefore application is allowed. The applicant is permitted to compromise the case on behalf of minor D4.

The plaintiff has filed suit for the relief of partition of the suit schedule properties. According to the plaintiff the suit schedule properties originally belonged to their grand father Late Appajishetty who had two sons namely Venkatappashetty and 1st defendant Subbanna. As per the revenue documents produced by the plaintiff the suit schedule properties are standing in

the name of plaintiff and defendants.
The compromise is in accordance with
law. Therefore compromise petition is
accepted. Suit is decreed in terms of
compromise.
