Petition Claim: Petition is filed by the petitioner under Section 166 of Motor vehicles Act seeking compensation of Rs.37,25,000/- with interest at the rate of 18 % p.a. on account of death of Late Sathish i.e husband of petitioner No.1 and father of petitioner Nos. 2 and 3 in a road traffic accident.

This suit coming on this day on **2nd day of April 2026** for final disposal before **Sri.Raju M., M.A, LLB.**, Senior Civil Judge & JMFC, Periyapatna and **Sri. K.B.S**, Advocate for Petitioner and Respondent no.1 exparte. **Sri. BMS**, advocate for Respondent no.2.

By pronouncing judgment, it is ordered and decreed that, Petition is allowed in part with costs.

Further it is ordered and decreed that, Petitioners Nos. 1 to 3 are entitled for compensation of Rs.17,47,200/-(Rupees Seventeen Lakhs Forty Seven thousand and Two hundred only) along with interest @ 6%

per annum from the date of petition till its realization.

Further it is ordered and decreed that, Respondent no.2 is liable to pay the compensation to the petitioners and it shall deposit the aforesaid compensation amount within 60 days from the date of judgment.

Further it is ordered and decreed that, petitioners no.1 to 3 are entitled for compensation at the ratio of 70:15:15.

Further it is ordered and decreed that, out of awarded amount 50% shall be released to petitioner no.1 and remaining 50% shall be deposited in her name, in any nationalized/scheduled Bank for a period of three years with liberty to withdraw accrued interest.

Further it is ordered and decreed that, considering the quantum of compensation amount awarded to the petitioner Nos.2 and 3 it is ordered to release compensation amount awarded to them respectively after its deposit and on proper identification.

It is further ordered and decreed that,
Advocate's fee is fixed at Rs. 1000/-.
