ORDER

This is the petition filed by the petitioners praying to issue direction to the respondent to enter the date of death of the husband of petitioner No.1 by name Puttarajappa S/o late Channabasappa, who expired on 14.05.1993 at Hitnahalli Village, Ravanduru Hobli, Periyapatna Taluk, Mysuru District., in the concerned register and to direct him to issue death certificate of husband of the petitioner No.1, after collecting the fee.

2. Background facts in a nut-shell are as under;

It is the case of the petitioners that, the husband of petitioner No.1 by name Puttarajappa S/o late

Channabasappa, who expired on 14.05.1993 at Hitnahalli Village, Ravanduru Hobli, Periyapatna Taluk, Mysuru District. But, petitioners could not registered the same with the registrar of births and deaths in time. Now, the petitioners are in need of death certificate of Puttarajappa S/o late Channabasappa, for the purpose of change of Katha and other purpose. Further, they contended that, they have filed the application before the respondent's office for issuance of death certificate of Puttarajappa S/o late Channabasappa, but the respondent has issued the endorsement regarding that, there is no such entry of date of death of husband of petitioner No.1 by name Puttarajappa S/o late Channabasappa, who expired on 14.05.1993 at Hitnahalli Village, Ravanduru Hobli, Periyapatna Taluk, Mysuru District, in the concerned register. Alleging the above facts the petitioners have filed this petition against the respondent.

3. The notice of petition was served to the respondent. But, the respondent remained absent. Further, the petitioners have taken paper publication with regard to filing of the present petition.

4. The petitioners in order to establish their case, the petitioner No.2 examined himself as PW.1 and got marked 7 documents as Ex.P1 to Ex.P7. Ex.P1 is the Non-Availability Certificate. Ex.P2 is the News Paper. Ex.P3 is the Genealogical Tree. Ex.P4 to 6 are the Notarized copy of Aadhar card of petitioners. Ex.P7 is the Certified copy of the Manual RTC Extract in respect of Sy.No.19/1. The PW.1 has filed examination-in-chief affidavit-in-lieu of his oral evidence.

5. Heard the arguments.

6. Upon hearing arguments and on perusal of materials placed on records, following points arises for consideration;

7. This court answers the above points as hereunder;

8. The PW.1 in his evidence has reiterated the averments made in the petition.

9. This court has gone through the evidence of PW.1, wherein he has clearly deposed that, petitioner No.1's husband by name Puttarajappa S/o late Channabasappa, who expired

on 14.05.1993 at Hitnahalli Village, Ravanduru Hobli, Periyapatna Taluk, Mysuru District. Further, the endorsement issued by the respondent reveals that, the date of death of husband of petitioner No.1 by name Puttarajappa S/o late Channabasappa, is not entered in the concerned register. Since the respondent has not appeared before the Court, the petition averments made in the affidavit has remained unchallenged. Therefore, Court has no option except to accept the same and come to the conclusion that, the date of death of the husband of petitioner No.1, who expired on 14.05.1993 at Hitnahalli Village, Ravanduru Hobli, Periyapatna Taluk, Mysuru District. There is no evidence to show that, non-intimation of the same to concerned authority is intentional one.

10. Under such circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that, if the respondent is directed to register the date of death of husband of petitioner No.1, who expired on 14.05.1993 at Hitnahalli Village, Ravanduru Hobli, Periyapatna Taluk, Mysuru District, in the concerned register, certainly it would meet the ends of justice. On the other hand, no hardship or loss will cause to the respondent. Hence, *this Court answered point No.1 in the **Affirmative.***

POINT NO.2:-

11. For the foregoing reasons, this court proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

The petition filed by the petitioners is hereby allowed.

The respondent is hereby directed to enter the date of death of husband of petitioner No.1 by name Puttarajappa S/o late Channabasappa(ಪುಟ್ಟರಾಜಪ್ಪ ಬಿನ್ ಲೇ.ಚನ್ನಬಸಪ್ಪ), who expired on 14.05.1993 at Hitnahalli Village, Ravanduru Hobli, Periyapatna Taluk, Mysuru District, in the concerned register of births and deaths and issue death certificate to the petitioners, after obtaining necessary fee in accordance with law.
