SUBSTANCE OF ACCUSATION

That, you accused received loan amount of Rs.2,00,000/- from the complainant, in repayment of the said amount, you issued Cheque bearing No.080712 dated 20.12.2017, an account maintained by you, in discharge of the debt. When the cheque was presented for encashment through the Vijaya Bank, Periyapatna Branch, Periyapatna Taluk, to Cauvery Kalpatharu Grameen Bank, Makodu Branch, Periyapatna Taluk, the cheque returned unpaid with an endorsement stating “**FUNDS INSUFICIENT**”. Despite the legal notice you have not paid the cheque amount and thereby you have committed an offence punishable Under Section 138 of NI Act. Within my cognizance.
