When the cheque was presented for encashment, the cheque returned unpaid with an endorsement stating **“INSUFFICIENT FUNDS”** on 29.03.2016. Despite the legal notice you have not paid the cheque amount and thereby you have committed an offence punishable Under Section 138 of NI Act. Within my cognizance.
