1. This is a bail application u/s 483 BNS moved on behalf of applicant/accused Rajesh seeking grant of regular bail in FIR no. 103/26 PS Budh Vihar.

2. It is submitted by ld. Counsel for applicant/accused that alleged recovery of 8.465kg of Ganja is below commercial quantity and Section 47 NDPS Act is not attracted, no independent public witness has been joined despite alleged recovery. It is further submitted that applicant is young man of 22 years of age and have clean antecedents and no previous criminal involvement.

3. It is submitted by the Ld. Sub. Addl. PP for the State that as per report of IO, 8.465kg of ganja has been recovered from applicant. It is further submitted that matter is still at the stage of investigation and FSL result is still pending hence, applicant may influence the witnesses and tamper with evidence. Hence, the bail application may be dismissed.

4. Heard. Perused.

5. Considering the fact that the applicant/accused is aged 22 years, no independent witnesses, no previous involvement, chargesheet has been filed and he had been in JC since 12.03.26 considering the totality of facts and circumstances and apprehension of State, I am of the view that no purpose will be served by keeping the applicant/accused in custody. Therefore, the application is allowed. Applicant/accused Rajesh is admitted to bail on furnishing personal bond in sum of Rs. 10,000/- with one surety of the like amount subject to the conditions that:

- (a) Applicant/accused shall not commit the same offence again & must not threaten the witnesses;
- (b) Applicant/accused shall provide his fresh address by way of an affidavit in the Court after his release and in case of any change in his address shall inform the Court;
- (c) Applicant/accused shall appear on each and every date of hearing before the Court.

6. Application stands disposed off. Copy dasti. Copy of this order be also sent to Jail Superintendent.
