2. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the defendant No.1 alienated the suit properties to the defendants No.2 to 5 and 7 behind the back of the plaintiffs and without the knowledge of them?
3. Whether the defendant No.6 proves that the suit is not maintainable for want of relief of declaration?
4. Whether the defendant No.6 proves that the suit is bad for non inclusion of other family properties?

5. Whether the defendant No.6 proves that the suit is barred by law and time?

6. Whether the defendants No.7 and 8 prove that defendant No.7 is the bonafide purchaser of item No.3 of the suit properties?

7. Whether the defendants No.6 to 8 prove that the court fee paid by the plaintiffs is incorrect?

6. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for partition and separate possession of 3/4th share in the suit properties?

7. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of declaration?
