ISSUES

1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that they are the absolute owners in possession of the suit property by virtue of gift deed dated 06.12.1946?
2. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the gift deed executed by one Muddaiah in favour of the defendant No.2 on 31.10.2012 relating to the suit property is null and void and not binding upon the plaintiffs?
3. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the sale deed executed by the defendant No.2 in favour of the defendant No.3 on 10.07.2012 relating to the suit property is null and void and not binding upon the plaintiffs?
4. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the partition deed dated 25.10.2018 executed between the defendants No.3 and 4 relating to the suit property is null and void and not binding upon the plaintiffs?

5. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the defendants have caused an interference to their possession and enjoyment of the suit property?
6. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to the relief of declaration, mandatory and permanent injunction?
7. What order or decree?
