ISSUES

1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the suit properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of them and the defendants No.2 and 3?

2. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the sale deed dated 17.07.2008 executed by the defendants No.2 and 3 to the defendant No.4 relating to the item No.5 of the suit properties and the sale deed dated 29.04.2009 executed by the defendants No.2 and 3 to the husband of the defendant No.5 relating to the item No.6 of them are not binding upon the plaintiffs?

3. Whether the defendants No.1 to 3 and 5 prove that there was oral partition in the family of the plaintiffs and the defendants No.1 to 3 in 2015?

4. Whether the defendants No.1 to 3 and 5 prove that the items No.5 and 6 of the suit properties were alienated for legal necessity of the family of the plaintiffs and the defendants No.1 to 3?

5. Whether the defendant No.5 proves that the suit is bad for non joinder of necessary parties?

6. Whether the defendant No.5 proves that her husband is the bonafide purchaser of item No.6 of the suit properties?

7. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to the relief of partition and separate possession of 2/5th share in the suit properties?

8. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to the relief of declaration?

9. What order or decree?
