ISSUES

1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the suit properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of the plaintiff No.1 and the defendant?

2. Whether the defendant proves that the suit properties were separate properties of her father and he executed the Will dated 02.02.2000 bequeathing an extent of 1 acre in item No.1 of the suit properties to the plaintiff No.1 and the remaining extent of 1 acres 5 guntas in the item No.1 of them and also the item No.2 of them to the defendant?

3. Whether the plaintiff No.1 is entitled to partition and separate possession of 1/2 share in the suit properties?

4. Whether the plaintiff No.1 is entitled to the relief of accounts of profits in the suit properties?

5. Whether the plaintiff No.1 is entitled to the declaration that the khatha entered in the name of the defendant is illegal, null and void and not binding on the plaintiff No.1?

6. What order or decree?
