

ORDER BELOW EXH. 01 IN S.C.C. NO.298/2022

01. As per letter issued by Hon'ble Bombay High Court Letter No.B(Gen)-1001/2023/32 dated 01/04/2023 and Hon'ble District & Session Court Thane outward No.CS/4768/2023 dated 13/04/2023 in respect of special drive for disposal of cases under Section 256 & 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

02. The accused is charge sheeted for committing the offence punishable u/s.283 of the Indian Penal Code. On perusal of record, it appears that, case is pending for appearance of accused. Police failed to execute the summons issued against accused. In such circumstances it would be just and proper to stop the proceeding by taking recourse of section 258 of Cr.P.C. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

1. The proceeding of this matter is stopped by taking recourse of section 258 of Criminal Procedure Code.
2. Accused is discharged for offence punishable under Section 283 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. Bail bonds of accused stands canceled.
