

### **ORDER**

The plaintiffs have filed this suit against the defendants for the relief of partition with respect to the suit schedule properties.

The plaintiffs have also filed I.A.No.I under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of C.P.C praying to grant order of temporary injunction restraining the defendants, their legal heirs, agents, servants, followers or any other persons claiming on their behalf from alienating the suit schedule properties till disposal of this suit.

The plaintiffs have produced mutation registers, RTCs, legal notice, postal receipts and postal acknowledgments etc.

On perusal of the pleadings and the documents filed by the plaintiffs, this Court is of the opinion that, the plaintiffs have made out

prima-facie case at this stage of grant temporary injunction. If temporary injunction is not granted as prayed, the purpose of filing the suit would be defeated and also it would cause hardship and inconvenience to the plaintiffs. Therefore, by considering the facts and circumstances, I proceed to pass the following:-

**ORDER**

Issue ad-interim temporary Injunction against the defendants. The defendants are hereby restrained temporarily from alienating the suit schedule properties till next date of hearing.

Issue T.I. after compliance of Order 39, Rule 3 of C.P.C.

Issue suit summons to defendants.
