

ORDER

The plaintiff has filed this suit against the defendants for the relief of declaration in respect of the suit schedule property.

The plaintiff has also filed IA.No.I under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 R/w 151 of C.P.C praying to grant order of temporary injunction restraining the defendants No.1 to 5, their agents, servants, legal representatives or anybody acting by or through them from interfering with the suit schedule property till disposal of this suit.

The plaintiff has produced adhar card, sale deed, dated 25/05/1973 and 14/10/1974, MR extract, pass book, index of land, RTC, application filed to Thasildar, notice, sketch, report, GPS photograph, complaint, acknowledgment, endorsement, flex print etc.

On perusal of the pleadings and the documents filed by the plaintiff, this Court is of the opinion that, the plaintiff has made out prima-facie case at this stage of grant temporary injunction. If temporary injunction is not granted as prayed, the purpose of filing the suit would be defeated and also it would cause hardship and inconvenience to the plaintiff. Therefore, by considering the facts and circumstances, I proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

Issue ad-interim temporary Injunction against the defendants No.1 to 5. The defendants No.1 to 5 are hereby restrained temporarily from interfering with the suit schedule property till next date of hearing.

Issue T.I. after compliance of Order 39, Rule 3 of C.P.C.

Issue suit summons to defendants.
