

ORDER ON I.A No.2

Instant suit has been filed by the plaintiff against the defendant for the relief of Permanent Injunction.

The plaintiff has filed I.A.No.2 under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 of CPC praying for an order of temporary injunction against the defendant, his henchmen, servants, legal representatives or anybody acting on his behalf from interfering into the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule property bearing Sy.No.89/1 measuring 0.20 guntas towards eastern side out of 1 acre bounded on the East by: Land belonging to Nanjundaiah, West by: Remaining land of Sy.No.89/1 belonging to C.P.Mahesh, North by: Land belonging to Marisiddaiah and South by: Land belonging to the plaintiff bearing Sy.No.90/5, situated at Chandahalli Village, Talakadu Hobli, T.Narasipura Taluk, Mysuru District in any manner till pending disposal of the suit.

Heard the arguments on I.A.No.2 and perused the documents produced by the plaintiff annexed to the plaint.

The plaintiff has produced the Original registered Sale Deed dated 03.06.1968, unregistered partition deed dated 06.11.2006, Mutation Order passed in MRH13/2016-17, Mutation Order passed in MRH20/2011-12, RTC extract of

the suit schedule property which discloses that the katha of the suit schedule property is standing in the name of the plaintiff, the Tax paid receipts, Patta and receipt Book, NCR acknowledgment issued by the Talakadu police.

By virtue of the pleadings and the documents placed on record the plaintiff has shown to this Court that he is in possession of the suit schedule property and as such the plaintiff has made out prima-facie case at this stage to grant ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction against the defendant as prayed for and accordingly the I.A. No.2 deserves to be allowed by dispensing issuance of notice to the defendant to meet the ends of justice. Hence, this court proceeds to pass the following:

ORDER

Issue Exparte Temporary Injunction Order against the defendant, his henchmen, servants, legal representatives or anybody acting on his behalf from interfering into the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule property bearing Sy.No.89/1 measuring 0.20 guntas towards eastern side out of 1 acre bounded on the East by: Land belonging to Nanjundaiah, West by: Remaining land of Sy.No.89/1 belonging to C.P.Mahesh, North by: Land belonging to Marisiddaiah and South by: Land belonging to the plaintiff

bearing Sy.No.90/5, situated at Chandahalli Village, Talakadu Hobli, T.Narasipura Taluk, Mysuru District in any manner till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply with Order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC. Issue T. I. Order notice to defendant and issue suit summons and notice of I.A.No.2 to the defendant. Office is directed to issue C/C of this order only on the compliance of Order 39 Rule 3(a) of the CPC by the plaintiff.
