

ORDERS

The DHR has filed an application U/s 151 of CPC seeking to permit him to deposit the balance sale consideration amount of Rs.1,80,000/- in the case.

In the affidavit, the DHR has stated that the Judgment debtors have not complied the judgment and decree passed in OS.No.18/2019. Hence, he has filed the present execution petition. Hence, he prays to permit him to deposit the balance consideration amount.

Perused the materials available on record.

The DHR herein has filed the suit in OS.No.18/2019 seeking for specific performance and it was decreed and directed the defendants to execute the sale deed by receiving the balance sale consideration amount of Rs.1,80,000/- within 3 months from the date of the order. However, the judgment debtors have failed to execute the sale deed by receiving the balance consideration. Hence, the DHR has filed the present execution petition.

In view of the above reason, it is necessary to permit the DHR to deposit the balance consideration amount of Rs.1,80,000/- in the case.
