

**Order On Bail Application filed U/S 480 of BNSS.**

Sri.B.S advocate for accused has filed vakalath with bail application U/s 480 of BNSS for releasing the accused on bail. In the application, she has stated that, she not committed any offences as alleged by the police and she is law abiding citizen. She undertakes to appear on all the hearing dates without fail. She undertakes to furnish surety to the satisfaction of this Court and undertakes to abide by the condition imposed by this Court.

The learned APP has filed objection and contended that, the alleged offences punishable U/s 115(2), 118(1), 352, 351(1) of BNS are non-bailable in nature. The minimum punishment is 3 years with fine. The details of the bail application are not true. The accused is not innocent. If the accused released on bail, she may abscond or threatened to prosecution witnesses. The accused may tamper the evidence of prosecution and release if she is likely to commit similar crimes in the future. Hence, prays to dismiss the application.

On perusal of the record, it appears that, the Talakadu Police Station have registered the case against the accused No.1 and 2 for the offences punishable U/s 115(2), 118(1), 352, 351(1) of BNS. Therefore, having regards to the facts and circumstances of case and considering the social background of the accused, this court is of the opinion that, it is a fit case to enlarge the accused on bail.

In view of the decision of the Hon'ble supreme court in Satyendra Kumar Antil case, the accused is entitled for bail. The apprehension of Learned APP may be met with imposing stringent condition. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

### **ORDER**

The bail application filed by the accused is hereby allowed. The accused is enlarged on bail on executing a personal bond of Rs.**25,000/-** with one surety like sum for the following conditions:

1. The accused shall be present before this Court on all hearing dates.
2. The accused shall not indulge in any offences.
3. The accused shall not tamper the prosecution witnesses and evidences.
