

Accused is present.

Sri.S.C.S., learned Advocate has filed Vakalath and bail application under Section 478 of B.N.S.S and prays to enlarge her on bail.

Learned counsel for the accused has also filed an application under Sec.70(2) of Cr.P.C., seeking cancellation of warrant issued against the accused.

Heard and Perused.

The reasons stated in the applications are satisfied. From last 3 hearing dates the accused has been absent and the warrant has been issued against her, it is necessary to allow the application by imposing the penalty.

Hence, the application filed under Section 70(2) Cr.P.C. is allowed on penalty of Rs.300/-.

Consequently, the warrant issued against the accused is canceled.

Issue intimation to the concerned Police about the cancellation of the warrant issued against the accused.

ORDERS ON BAIL APPLICATION
U/SEC. 478 of B.N.S.S.

In the bail application it is contended that, accused has not committed any offence alleged against

her and she is the innocent, law abiding citizen and coming from good families. The alleged offence is bailable in nature and also triable by this court. Further, the alleged offence is not punishable death or life imprisonment. She is ready to furnish the surety to the satisfaction of the Court for her release on bail. Hence, prays to allow the bail application and release the accused.

Heard. Perused the bail application and documents available on record.

The offence alleged against the accused is punishable U/Sec.138 of N.I. Act. The offence alleged is bailable in nature and triable by this Court and is not punishable either death or life imprisonment. The accused is entitled for a bail as a matter of right. Hence, I feel it is just and proper to allow the bail application and proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

The bail application filed by the accused U/Sec.478 of B.N.S.S is **allowed** subject to the following conditions:-

1. The accused shall execute the personal bond for Rs.50,000/- with one surety for the like sum.

2. The accused shall appear before the Court regularly.
