ACCUSATION

That you the accused had borrowed a hand loan for a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- on 11.04.2024 from the complainant for her necessities such as family necessities and to discharge the hand loans and agreed to repay the same within 2 ½ months and after lapse of stipulated period complainant demanded to you to repay the said amount for which you have issued a post dated cheque bearing No.092238 dated:26.06.2024 for Rs.1,50,000/- drawn on Bank of India, Bannur Branch, to the complainant and the complainant presented the said cheque for collection before the Bank of Baroda, Kaggalipura Branch, it was dishonoured and returned with a shara of **“Insufficient Funds”** on 04.07.2024 and further you failed to make payment of the cheque amount even after 15 days of service of notice of dishonour and thereby committed an offence punishable U/Sec.138 of N.I. Act.
