ACCUSATION

That you the accused had borrowed a hand loan for a sum of Rs.8,00,000/- on 09.05.2024 for his family legal necessities, for lorry repairs and to discharge hand loans from the complainant and agreed to repay the same within 2 months. On the same day for which you have issued a post dated cheque bearing No.364744 dated:09.07.2024 for Rs.8,00,000/- drawn on State Bank of India, College Road, T.Narasipura Branch, to the complainant and as per the request of the accused the complainant presented the said cheque for collection on 09.07.2024 before Canara Bank, T.Narasipura Branch, it was dishonoured and returned with a shara of "**Funds Insufficient**" on 10.07.2024 and further you failed to make payment of the cheque amount even after 15 days of service of notice of dishonour and thereby committed an offence punishable U/Sec.138 of N.I. Act.
