BEFORE THE LOK ADALATH

After due conciliation by the Court both the plaintiffs and the defendants have agreed to compromise the case and accordingly filed compromise petition, stating that they have compromised the case in terms of compromise petition. The contents of compromise petition are read over and explained to the both parties in the language known to them. They have admitted its contents as true and correct. On enquiry they also submitted that they have no force, threat or undue influence to get the case compromised.

Therefore, there is no impediment to accept the proposed compromise of the parties. Accordingly, I pass the following order:

::AWARD::

The Compromise Petition filed by the plaintiffs and the defendants is hereby accepted and allowed. Consequently, the suit filed by the plaintiffs is hereby decreed subject to the terms and conditions of the Compromise Petition.

The Compromise Petition shall be treated as part and parcel of the Award.

Having regard to the nature of the suit and facts and circumstances of the case the parties shall bear their own cost.

Office is directed to draw Award accordingly in terms of Compromise Petition.
