On 18/03/2025 the complainant presented the said cheque for collection before State Bank of India, T.Narasipura Branch and it returned for the reasons **“Funds Insufficient”** on 19/03/2025 and further you failed to make payment of the cheque amount even after 15 days service of notice of dishonour and thereby committed an offence punishable U/s 138 of N.I.Act.
