ORDER

This petition is filed under Section **482 of BNSS** for anticipatory bail in Cr.No.**81/2026** of Sindhanur Rural Police Station which is registered for the offences punishable u/Ss.126(2), 352, 115(2), 74, 351(2), 133, 3(5) of BNS.

2. The petitioners have contented that, they are innocent of the alleged offences and false case has been foisted against them; there are no reasonable grounds to believe that they are guilty of the offences alleged against them; they are permanently residing in the address mentioned in cause title, they does not have any criminal antecedents; they are ready to co-operate with the investigation and ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by the court. On these amongst other grounds shown in the petition they prayed for anticipatory bail.

3. The prosecution in the objection has contended that there are sufficient grounds to believe that petitioners have committed the said offences, if released on bail they may not co-operate with the investigation and may commit similar offences; they may tamper the prosecution witnesses. On these grounds prosecution has prayed to reject the petition.

4. Heard argument of both sides and perused the records.

5. The only point that arises for my consideration is:

Whether the petitioners are entitled for anticipatory bail ?

6. My finding is in the **affirmative** for the following:

REASONS

7. The case of the prosecution as could be seen from the records is that on 24.2.2026 at about 6.00 p.m., the complainant and his wife Manisha Sikadar were proceeding towards RH Camp-3, Sindhanur. At that time, the accused due to previous enmity, came there, wrongfully restrained them, abused the complainant in filthy language stating that he has already finished his brother at Maharashtra and he will also kill him. When the wife of the complainant questioned the act of the accused, the accused abused her in filthy language, made her to fall on the ground by assaulting her and used criminal force against her with an intention to outrage her modesty. Again the accused assaulted the wife of the complainant with chappal and threatened them.

8. There is previous enmity between the complainant and accused and due to that, present case has been registered. The offence u/S.74 of BNS is only the non-bailable offence shown in the FIR. Such offence is not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. The other offences are bailable in nature. Custodial interrogation of the petitioner may not be required. The petitioner is residing within the jurisdiction of this court and hence, his presence can be secured easily. If he is arrested, he would be humiliated. Thus, it is a fit case to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, I answer this point in the affirmative and proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

The petition filed under Sec.482 of BNSS, is hereby allowed.

The Sindhanur Rural police is hereby directed to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in Cr.No.**81/2026**, on executing personal bond for a sum of Rs.50,000/- each with one surety for the like-sum, subject to the following conditions;

1. He shall surrender before the concerned court within 15 days from the date of this order and execute personal & surety bonds.
2. He shall furnish ID proof of himself and surety.
3. He shall co-operate with the investigation.
4. He shall not tamper or threaten the prosecution witnesses.
