ORDER

This petition is filed under Section 482 of BNSS, for anticipatory bail in Cr.No.**76/2026** of Sindhanur Town Police Station which is registered for the offences punishable under Sections 85, 115(2), 351(2) R/w Sec.3(5) of BNS and u/Ss.3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

2. The petitioners have contented that, they are innocent of the alleged offences and false case has been foisted against them; there are no reasonable grounds to believe that they are guilty of the offences alleged against them; they are permanently residing in the address mentioned in cause title, they do not have any criminal antecedents; they are ready to co-operate with the investigation and ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by the court. On these amongst other grounds shown in the petition they prayed for anticipatory bail.

3. The prosecution in the objection has contended that there are sufficient grounds to believe that petitioners have committed the said offences, if released on bail they may commit similar offences; they may not co-operate with investigation and tamper the prosecution witnesses. On these grounds prosecution has prayed to reject the petition.

4. Heard argument of both sides and perused the records.

5. The only point that arises for my consideration is:

Whether the petitioners are entitled for anticipatory bail ?

6. My finding is in the affirmative for the following;

REASONS

7. The case of the prosecution as could be seen from the records is that the marriage of the complainant was performed with accused No.1 on 1.2.2019 by giving 2 tolas gold. Thereafter, the petitioners started to harass the complainant both physically and mentally by demanding additional dowry of Rs.5,00,000/- to meet out the loan. It is alleged that on 24.2.2026 at about 12.00 noon, accused No.1 abused the complainant in filthy language by demanding additional dowry and voluntarily caused hurt to her.

8. There is matrimonial dispute between the complainant and accused No.1. Excluding the offences u/Ss.85 and u/Ss.3 and 4 of DP Act, other offences are bailable in nature. The said offences are not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. The petitioners are having permanent residence and their presence can be secured easily for the purpose of trial. Whether the petitioners have committed the offence is to be testified during the trial. Petitioner No.2 is woman. The custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required. If the petitioners are arrested, they would be humiliated. Therefore, the petitioners are to be released on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, I answer this point in the affirmative and proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

The petition filed under Sec.482 of BNSS, is hereby allowed.

The Sindhanur Town Police is hereby directed to release the petitioners on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest in Cr.No.**76/2026**, on executing personal bonds for a sum of Rs.50,000/- each with one surety for the like-sum, subject to the following conditions;

1. They shall surrender before the concerned court within 15 days from the date of this order and execute personal & surety bonds.
2. They shall furnish ID proof of themselves and surety.
3. They shall co-operate with the investigation.
4. They shall not tamper or threaten the prosecution witnesses.
