The plaintiff filed this application U/o.3 rule 2 of CPC to permit this applicant to proceed with case through his GPA holder.

2. In the affidavit contended that, the plaintiff filed this suit for declaration and injunction. The applicant contended that due to old age and in view of heart operation applicant unable to attend the Hon'ble court in order to give evidence. Hence the applicant has executed the power of attorney in favour of his son by name Sitakantacharya S/o. Raghavendra is empower to give evidence and other necessary acts and deeds as shown in the GPA. Hence prays to allow the application.

3. On the other hand, in spite of giving sufficient opportunity, the defendant did not file the objection.

4. Heard the counsel.

5. After going through the materials available on record the plaintiff filed this suit for declaration and injunction against the defendants. The plaintiff filed this application to proceed the case through GPA holder. The GPA holder is the son of the plaintiff. As per the law a person can authorize anyone to act on behalf of himself at any time. Hence it is necessary to allow the application in the interest of justice.
