In pursuance of summons issued to PW Anju, one Riya @
Anju has appeared before this Court. The dispute regarding the identity
of the witness was raised after her part examination in chief was
recorded. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for accused Bijli @ Kinnar and
Hasina has disputed the identity of the witness and it has been submitted
upon the instructions of the accused persons, that Riya @ Anju is not the
same witness namely Anju D/o Gurdayal. The further examination in

chief is deferred since the identity of the witness is disputed by the accused persons.

Let, the IO be present before this Court on the NDOH and to verify the identity of the witness.

PW Riya @ Anju is bound down for the NDOH.

Let fresh summons be issued to PW Sarvesh through IO/ SHO concerned for the next date of hearing.
