Proceedings against accused Deepak have stood abated vide
order dated 23.01.2020.

On 20.04.2024, accused Hasina had failed to appear before this Court and NBW's were issued against her. On 10.05.2024, an application was moved on behalf of applicant/accused Hasina for cancellation of NBW's.

It has been submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the accused/applicant Hasina that the accused could not appear before this Court as she had to travel out of Delhi for some urgent work, however, she could not get in touch with her previous counsel. Therefore, the appropriate application seeking exemption on personal appearance could not be moved on her behalf.

On the LDOH, this Court had stayed the execution of the NBW's against her.

Since, the accused Hasina has appeared in person and she has undertaken to appear regularly before this Court on each and every date of hearing, the application seeking cancellation of NBW's is here by allowed. Her previous bail bond/surety bond is hereby restored.

Today the matter is fixed for PE.

Summons issued to PW Dr. Sahil received back as duly served.

PW3 Dr. Deepak Chugh has been examined, cross examined and discharged as a witness.

PW Sonu is present, however, he has submitted that since he is not feeling well, his testimony may be recorded on some other date.

On the LDOH, this court had allowed the exemption application moved on behalf of the accused Suraj, subject to furnishing the medical documents. The medical documents are not filed by the accused person.

It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the accused Suraj that the cost of Rs. 5,000/- may be reduced, since the accused does not have the financial wherewithal to pay the same.

In the interest of justice, the cost amount is reduced from Rs. 5,000/- to Rs. 2,000/-.

The cost of Rs. 2,000/- is paid before DLSA, North East. The receipt is taken on record.

Let fresh summons be issued to PW IO ASI Veerpal Singh through SHO concerned for the next date of hearing.

Now to come up for PE on **08.08.2024**.

Date has been given as per the specific request of the Ld. Counsel for the accused persons.
