

ORDERS ON I.A.No.I

The petitioner filed I.A.No.I, U/o.XXVI Rule 9 R/w.Sec.151 of CPC to appoint the Court Commissioner to effect the partition as per the preliminary decree passed in O.S.No.99/2024 dated 06.08.2025.

2. Due to exparte objection taken as not filed.
3. Heard the petitioners side.
4. After going through the materials available on record, the petitioners filed this petition for final decree proceedings in respect of the preliminary decree passed in O.S.No.99/2024 dated 06.08.2025. The petitioners furnished the certified copy of Judgment and decree. In the said judgment, the plaintiffs are entitled 1/3rd share each in the suit schedule property by meets and bounds. Hence, it is necessary to appoint court commissioner to effect the partition in respect of landed properties. Hence, it is necessary to allow the application. Hence, this Court proceed to pass the following;
